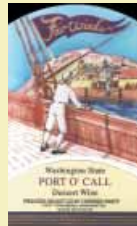
We produce both fruit and grape wines at our family-owned vineyard, orchard and winery located on 20 rolling acres overlooking Tumwater Creek. **Directions:** Follow Hwy. 101 W from downtown Port Angeles. Turn right onto Pine Street Extension (just before the Black Diamond Road overpass). At the stop sign, turn left onto Pine Street, which becomes Black Diamond Road. Continue south about 3 miles — look for our sign and vineyard on the right.

Otto Street parallels Hwy. 20, between Fredericks Street and Seton Road. Turn east off of Hwy. 20 onto Seton Road if approaching from the south. Coming from Port Townsend, turn east onto Fredericks Street, go to Otto Street and follow the signs.

We invite you to come visit the farm, taste our unique ciders and fruit wines, walk the fields and orchards, and connect with life on the land. **Directions:** Located 2.7 miles south of the Chimacum 4-way intersection off Center Road (about 15 miles south of Port Townsend). Look for the Finnriver sign and turn onto Country Meadow Road. Proceed a half mile and park at the big red barn.
